





A workshop for pre-pubertal girls.

The age of the first period in Goa has dropped to ages 9-10. Girls start experiencing pubertal changes years before their period hits. 75% of Indian girls don't know what a period is before it happens to them. With the age of puberty dropping lower and lower, we can expect that number to increase. Therefore this workshop was conceptualised.

An introduction to puberty and all its myriad changes to girls who havent encountered it yet. It seeks to cover the anatomy both internal and external, what a period is, why it happens and other aspects of puberty, stressing how normal it is and how it happens to everyone. Girls are shown various period products and how to use them, with an open, non-judgmental atmosphere, allowing the kids to ask any questions they may have. Taboo and myths are categorically dispelled. A fun aspect is "bedazzling the uterus." Girls are given an outline of the uterus and colours, stickers, etc. and allowed to go crazy – empowering them further.




